Opening balance as of the last meeting on July 13th was \$3753.89. Outgoing expenses totalled \$136.74, and included \$100 to Pennywise for our Treasure Hunt account, and \$36.74 to Hall Printing for the Treasure Hunt posters. \$15 in anonymous donations to the Treasure Fund were deposited to the general account, since we didn't have enough to open the separate subaccount for the Treasure Hunt without incurring monthly fees, and a cheque for the same amount was then written to the Hospice Society, the chosen recipient of the Treasure Fund. \$5 cents interest was paid in both July and August.
